

# 2020 COMMUNITY DIALOGUE MINI-GRANT AWARDS

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## HIGHLAND SCHOOL

Mini grant award: \$332

**Project:** Funding for AWARE Club to focus on designing “I’m Aware” wristbands for all students, increasing posters about where to get help, and creating a “Fearless” Wall after Darryl Bellamy’s presentation



# TAYLOR MIDDLE SCHOOL

**Mini grant award:** \$300

**Project:** Implementing a Wall of 'Paws'itivity in a central location within their school

Possible ideas to follow about redesigning their FAR room and revamping outdoor space



# WARRENTON MIDDLE SCHOOL

**Mini grant award:** \$500

**Project:** Funding for in-school club to increase peer support. Topics addressed in the club will include anxiety, stress, peer relationships, positive communication, coping skills and more.





# MARSHALL MIDDLE SCHOOL

Mini grant award: \$600

**Project:** Create a space for students to share information about mental health issues. Funding will be used to create pencils for all students with #FEARLESS on them. Will also be used for stress balls and materials to promote mental wellness



# KETTLE RUN HIGH SCHOOL

Mini grant award: \$337

**Project:** Funding for after-school club focusing on creating a more inclusive environment for people with mental health issues or students wanting additional support. Goal is to increase mentorship opportunities among seniors and freshmen.





# AUBURN MIDDLE SCHOOL

**Mini grant award:** \$500

**Project:** Establish "YES" (Youth Education Squad) group where students discuss topics related to mental wellness and work to decrease stigma. Funding will also support creating a "Zen Den" and increasing posters around the school
