What is Inpatient, IOP and PHP?

Inpatient is a type of treatment that an individual is hospitalized in a setting designed to help with mood disorders.

IOP stands for intensive outpatient treatment. IOP is intensive but allows individuals to still attend school or work. Individuals attend three evenings per week and the treatment includes behavioral and logic skills, psychoeducation and mindfulness training.

PHP stands for partial hospitalization program. This is a very structured treatment program that is less intensive than inpatient settings, and it is used to mood disorders and substance abuse
